1. Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center (CG PSC) has approved the results of OCS-R Selection Panel 06-25, which convened IAW Refs A and B on 17 December 2024. The panel recommended the following individuals as primary and alternate candidates to receive appointments to OCS class convenings on 21 April 2025 or 02 September 2025.

2. Pending final adjudication of all commissioning requirements, primary selectees 1 through 45 are tentatively scheduled to attend OCS on 21 April 2025, and primary selectees 46 through 75 are tentatively scheduled to attend OCS on 02 September 2025. The primary selectee list will be exhausted before alternate selectees are offered to attend OCS. Therefore, if a primary selectee withdraws or is dropped from the 21 April 2025 OCS class, the remaining primary selectees could potentially shift to fill that class.

Final appointment to the rank of ensign is contingent upon meeting all commissioning eligibility requirements, remaining fully qualified in accordance with references A through E, and successfully completing OCS.

6. This announcement is for planning purposes only and is not authority to issue travel orders to OCS. Members with dependents will be issued TAD orders. Members without dependents will be issued TEMDUIN orders.

7. Recruiters shall ensure all primary and alternate selectees SF-86 information is current, then release the SF-86 in EApp upon receipt of this message to initiate a Tier 3 investigation.
