This guide provides the procedures for you to view and print your Reserve Points Statement in Direct Access (DA). A new section was added to aid in verifying your information.

### **Information**

The Reserve Points Statement is **one of the most important documents** for a Reservist. Reservists should review the statement regularly and report any discrepancies immediately to their command.

### **Known Issue**

PPC ADV is aware of a data issue affecting the points statement summary for some Reserve members. This issue may cause inconsistencies in points totals, potentially dating back to 2014. While the problem has been resolved to prevent future inaccuracies, we encourage all members to review their points statements for accuracy.

The ADV Service Validation Team is actively reviewing and correcting past errors. Members nearing retirement (RET2 status) are being prioritized for this process. You will be individually notified if a correction is made to your points statement.

### Corrections

If any discrepancy is discovered on the statement, submit a request for correction with supporting documents via the chain of command to the P&A Office. In cases where the P&A cannot resolve, the P&A shall provide meaningful endorsement with any additional supporting documents available and forward the request to PPC Customer Care. 
### **Important**

Keep in mind the difference between "Total Qualifying Years" and the checkbox for "Qualifying Years".

- The Total Qualifying Years calculates "complete years" (365/366 days).
- The checkbox is for a year that qualifies as good for retirement (meets the minimum number of points).


