JKO Mobile

JKO Mobile is a mobile application ("app") that you can download to a mobile device such as a mobile phone or tablet.

With JKO Mobile, you can:

- Get the latest JKO news
- Download unclassified working aids
- Download and take unclassified courses on your mobile device

JKO Mobile Access

- The JKO Mobile App is available in both the Apple and Android app stores (search for JKO)
- JKO Mobile is compatible with the iOS 6+ and Android 4.0+ Operating Systems (OS)
- The JKO Mobile App is free to download and use
- Public & Controlled Access available

JKO Mobile PIN

The JKO Mobile App requires a Personal Identification Number (PIN) to open the app. To obtain your PIN, you will need to complete course, J7OP-US1126 on the JKO LCMS. To enroll:

- 1. Log on to the https://jkodirect.jten.mil
- 2. Ensure your profile has the correct organization.
- 3. Select "Course Catalog."
- Enroll in J7OP-US1126.
- 5. Complete the course to obtain a PIN.

Public Access

- Grants the public access to:
 - Courses
 - Books
 - Videos
 - Podcasts
- Does not require a PIN
- Will NOT produce a completion certificate for completed content
- Very limited content. PIN recommended.

JKO Mobile Process

- Complete this "Intro to JKO Mobile" course on the JKO LCMS and WRITE DOWN YOUR PIN.
- Download the JKO Mobile app from app store, type in your PIN and download the course from the list available.
- Course completions are sent to the desktop JKO LCMS when you have connectivity. You can get your certificate there if needed. (You cannot get a certificate from your mobile device due to PII limitations.)

App Constraints

- If you started a JKO course from your desktop, or from your mobile device, you will not be able to switch back and forth to complete the same course. This is a future enhancement.
- Mobile device operating systems (OS) older than iOS 6 and Android 4.0. should work; however, there may be limitations due to technology enhancements.
