



The Office of Leadership (CG-128) is pleased to announce that DHS has been invited to send **TWO** representatives to the US Army's Senior Leader Seminar. **For this seminar DHS is receiving two (2) billets and one (1) alternate.**

The seminar will be held March 24-29, 2019 at the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service National Conservation Training Center (NCTC) in Shepherdstown, WV. The seminar is intended to enhance the preparation of GS-15 civilian employees for service at the national level. This program is designed to better prepare attendees to serve in key strategic and advisory positions by exposing them to the insights and perspectives of a wide variety of notable strategic-level practitioners from both the public and private sector.

#### **FUNDING**

This program is fully funded through the US Army War College. The US Army War College will pay for travel, provide lodging and meals, and pay incidentals "In Accordance With Joint Travel Regulation" as defined by DOD. Components are responsible for normal pay and allowances.

#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- GS-15 or TSA equivalent (No, U.S. Coast Guard military members may apply)
- Possess a Secret clearance
- Works in key position at the national level
