Veteran Accelerated Management Program

Our Veteran Accelerated Management Program (VAMP) pilots will run in 2017 through the University of Texas at Austin McCombs School of Business and Texas A&M University Mays School of Business.

The Veteran Accelerated Management Program combines 5 months of distance learning in business fundamentals (Marketing, Finance, Accounting, Operations) with 2 months of comprehensive residential graduate level business instruction. This highly engaging and interactive program utilizes cases, presentations, simulations, performance assessments, guest speakers, and the first-ever Psychology of the Veteran Transition to ensure Veterans are well-prepared for the challenges that await them in the corporate sector. Not only are these veterans developing the business acumen they need to succeed in the corporate world, but they are also provided world-class career services including resume development, mock interviews, and networking techniques.

During the residential education module, Veterans can choose from 1 of 2 capstone options:

Micro-Consulting Capstone

Embedded with a corporate partner in a small group to address a corporate level issue. At the conclusion of the course, teams will report their findings and recommendations to their clients.

Veteran Entrepreneurial Capstone

Engage in the business model generation for their very own start-ups. This capstone culminates in a pitch competition to a panel of venture capitalists, angel investors, and serial entrepreneurs. At the conclusion of the course, Veterans have the option to apply for the Bunker Labs or The Jonas Project to continue with the execution of their start-ups.
