CERCLA Action



The Coast Guard is working in collaboration with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to develop an appropriate remedial strategy to initiate a removal action at Slip 36 at Base Seattle, to include a portion of adjacent waters. Slip 36 is within the Harbor Island Superfund Site. This action would include removal of contaminated sediment and source materials, and potentially the removal and replacement of structures that impede the removal action, as identified through the remedial investigation process.

the U.S. **Pursuant** to Coast Guard Environmental Planning Policy and CEQ's Regulations for Implementing the Procedural Provisions of the National Environmental Policy Act, the Coast Guard will address NEPA concepts (e.g., analysis of off-site, ecological, and socioeconomic impacts to the extent practicable) in Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA) documents and will CERCLA public follow involvement requirements.

Work conducted under CERCLA will be considered to be part of the baseline conditions for purposes of analysis in the PEIS.
