LCDR Wes Agee Serves as the Executive Officer of Coast Guard Base Los Angeles/Long Beach providing premier mission support to 17 tenant commands and regional staffs, 43 Southern California area units, over 2,900 members. Services include medical, finance, engineering, purchasing, electronic pay administration, education, and worklife support. His most recent assignment was as the Senior Construction Manager in Puerto Rico for Facilities Design and Construction Center, responsible for a \$327M, six project portfolio and based out of San Juan, Puerto Rico.

LCDR Agee previously served as the Deputy Facilities Engineer for Coast Guard Base Alameda for four years from 2017-2021, executing the facilities maintenance program for 2.4M sqft of buildings and 700 acres of land, dispersed between eight separate sites. He also served as the first Facilities Engineer for Coast Guard Base Cleveland from 2016-2017, responsible for implementing the Shore Organizational Level Maintenance program for District 9.

LCDR Agee earned a Master of Science in Civil Engineering at the University of California, Irvine in 2016. Prior to this, he began his Coast Guard Civil Engineering Career at Coast Guard Civil Engineering Unit Oakland where he was assigned from 2011-2014. He served as a Construction Project Manager and District 11 Facility Asset Manager, responsible for prioritizing an annual budget of \$12M and providing crucial maintenance and repair projects to operational units. LCDR Agee's first assignment in the Coast Guard was as the Damage Control Assistant aboard USCGC GALLATIN (WHEC-721), homeported in Charleston, South Carolina from 2009-2011.

He received his commission from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy in 2009 with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering. His military awards include Coast Guard Commendation Medals, Coast Guard Achievement Medals, the Commandant's Letter of Commendation Ribbon, the Humanitarian Service Medal, and various other team and unit awards from his assignments. LCDR Agee is a licensed Professional Civil Engineer in the State of California and is a certified Project Management Professional (PMP).

LCDR Agee is married to the former Annette Boston from Oceanside, CA, with their children Angela, Benji, and Maya. Annette is a graduate of the U.S. Coast Guard Academy, where she earned a Bachelor of Science in Marine and Environmental Science.
